What's this research for?

Funded by the National Institute for Health Research's Invention for Innovation programme, specialist technology company Therapy Box is leading a collaboration to take their machine learning-based app to the clinic so that speech and language therapists in England and Wales can more quickly assess children's language, supporting them to identify children with DLD and then plan the support that child needs.

The innovative collaboration between Therapy Box, Bristol Speech and Language Therapy Research Unit, Newcastle University and three NHS sites in Hackney, Newcastle, and Bristol will take place across two years. At the start of the project, the team will be seeking 600 children to record their stories, to help train the app to recognise the children having trouble with their language. In the second year of the project, the app will be put through its paces by speech and language therapists and families coming to clinics for assessment.

What will I do?

You will create a profile for the account where you will provide some basic information on your *Age, Gender, Language, Location*, whether you have a known *Language and/or Speech Disability and whether you have any other disability*. You will then watch a short narrated story about a quest for treasure. Following this, you will take part in three assessments: Story Retell, Repetition and Comprehension. For Story retell, you will record your own narration of the story. Repetition involves listening to a sentence and then recording yourself repeating the same sentence. Finally, for Comprehension, you will answer multiple-choice questions related to the story. This process should take between 10-15 minutes. After completing the assessment, you have the option to play the app's game, where you control a pirate ship with the aim of collecting as many coins as possible, while simultaneously avoiding obstacles. You are free to play this game as many or as few time as you would like.

Terms of Use of the Application

This TERMS OF USE ("Agreement") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or an entity you represent or work for) and Therapy Box, Sun Studios, 30 Warple Way, Acton, London W3 0RX

Scope of Terms of Use of the Application

This Agreement applies to and governs your use of and access to Therapy Box's application Explorer.

Acceptable Uses

1. To use the application as intended by the creator (Therapy Box).
2. To complete the assessment yourself, and without the assistance of any other individuals.

Prohibited Uses

1. You may not knowingly enter any false information during the registration process.
2. You may not get anyone else to take the assessment on your behalf.
3. You may not try to extract data from or hack into the Mobile Application
4. You may not distribute, make available, assign or convey the Material without prior written permission from Therapy Box. You may not sell, lease, or license the Material.
5. You may not distribute, lease, sell, make available, assign, license or convey any derivative work (such as but not limited to, alteration, translation, reduction, expansion or inclusion) based on the Material.
6. You may not use images from the Material in printed or electronic publications or displays, other than as expressly permitted by this Agreement, without the prior written approval from Therapy Box.

Breaches of the Agreement

If you breach the terms in this Agreement in any way, Therapy Box may take such action as Therapy Box deems appropriate to deal with the breach, including suspending your access to the application.

Other Terms

Therapy Box may, at its sole discretion, make changes to this Agreement. The Agreement will be identified by its publication date and will be effective immediately upon being published. Your use of the Material after changes to the Agreement become effective constitutes your acceptance of such changes.

Terms and use of data

Therapy Box is committed to protecting the privacy of its users. We always inform you what personal data we obtain, use and store your data.

What data we collect

As part of the ATLAS project, Language Explorer will record children's responses to a Story Retell task, Comprehension task, and Repetition task. Characteristics about the user, including *Age, Gender, Language, Location*, whether they have a known *Language and/or Speech Disability* and whether they have any other *disability*, will be recorded. The purpose of this is to create an anonymised standardised dataset comprised of a suitable representation across all these characteristics.

Age: The *Birth Month* and *Birth Year* of the user is recorded so that their data contributes to the correct age group of the resulting standardised data. Exact Date of birth is not required and is not collected to prevent collecting unnecessary personally identifiable information.

Location: For users in the UK, the *first half of your postcode* is collected to ensure we have a balanced representation of data across England and Wales in our standardised dataset. For users outside of the UK, we collect *Country*. The exact location is not required and is not collected to prevent collecting unnecessary personally identifiable information.

Gender: The *Gender* of the user is recorded to ensure our standardised dataset comprises of an equal representation of each gender.

Language: The user's First and Second languages are recorded. It is important for us to understand whether English is the user's primary language.

Speech/Language disability: We collect this in order to ensure we have a suitable representation across all users.

Other Disability: We collect this in order to ensure we have a suitable representation across all users.

In addition to this, we will record your performance on the app's three assessments.

Is the data we collect anonymous?

Yes. We won't know who you are. We don't ask for your name or for any other identifying information.

How we collect your data

The data collection methodology for Explorer ensures the data collected is anonymised and the user is not identifiable. This is achieved by collecting data on the user which cannot be used to identify them. To prevent the user from being identified from the data we collect, we only collect specific elements of their personal data. When recording the age of the participant, we only collect their Birth Month and Year. When requesting the user's location, we only require the user to provide the first half of their Post Code.

The GDPR does not apply to personal data rendered anonymous in such a manner that the data subject is not or no longer identifiable (Recital 26 of the GDPR). Consequently, the GDPR's remit does not apply to the data collected in Explorer. As a result, the user is unable to ask for the right to erasure of their data. As the data is anonymous, Therapy Box would be unable to locate a user's data to delete it.

Why we collect your data

Data about the user's *Age, Gender, Language, Location*, whether they have a known *Language and/or Speech Disability and whether they have any other disability* is recorded. This data is recorded to create a standardised dataset on the communicative ability of Children across England and Wales. This will allow users of the app to compare their communicative abilities to others across the country.

How we store your data

All data is processed and stored in the UK (London).

Security

We are committed to ensuring your information is secure. Data collected on the app is transmitted via transport layered security (https), and recordings are stored encrypted at rest on Amazon Web Services.

Links to other websites

Our apps may contain links to other websites of interest (including social media pages such as facebook and twitter). However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over that other website. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. You should exercise caution and look at the privacy statement applicable to the website in question

Who does Therapy Box pass my data onto and what are the future uses of the collected data?

The anonymised data collected from this research may be used in other Therapy Box products and collaborative projects in the future. The only situations in which Therapy Box will share your data with a Third-Party is if: 1) we're required by law to do so, or 2) we are working on a collaborative project with another party in which this data could be of use.
